

NASHOTAH GENERAL INFORMATION

AMBULANCE

Ambulance with paramedic service is provided by the Lake Country Fire & Rescue by calling 911.

ASSESSMENT

The assessed value reflects the fair market value of a property (what someone would pay for the property). Assessment information, including age, square footage, fair market value, sales price, etc. can be obtained from the assessor, Magnan Assessment (542-3332). Assessment and tax information can be found on-line at waukeshacounty.gov –TAX LISTING. Assessments are made annually as of January 1 of each year. The assessment roll is usually available for inspection in the Clerk's Office late April.

ATTORNEY

John Macy is the Village Attorney. Contact can only be made by the Village Clerk/Treasurer and/or the Village President. Persons submitting items requiring Village Attorney review, i.e. Plan Commission agenda items, must first complete a Fees For Service Agreement.

BOATS

Nashotah residents are entitled to use the Bleeker Street boat launch on Nagawicka Lake in the City of Delafield. Permits can be obtained at the Delafield City Hall (646-6220). Proof of residency is required along with the Vehicle Identification Number and license plate number. Please contact the Delafield City Hall for the current fee.

BUILDING PERMITS

Building permit applications are available on the village web-site or from the Clerk's Office. For information on whether or not a permit is required, contact the Building Inspector, Tom Marks (490-0513).

Applications are not processed until all forms are completed and submitted at one time. Thus, electrical/plumbing/heating applications are to be completed and returned with the building permit applications along with the completed bond form, if required. Processing takes from 3 days to 2 weeks depending on work load and applications pending.

Permits are not required for fences, landscaping, driveways, re-roofing & re-siding unless opening sizes for doors, windows, etc. are changed.

BURN PERMITS

Permit no longer required. Must follow ordinance found on website.

CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

Christmas trees and wreaths should be put out with the regular garbage. Christmas trees should be cut in sections so they do not exceed 4 feet in length.

DOGS

Dogs 5 months of age or older as of January 1st must be licensed prior to April 1st. A \$10 late fee per license is assessed after April 1st. Within 30 days of ownership of a new dog, or within 30 days from the date the dog becomes 5 months old, a license is required.

The following rabies vaccination information is required: date of vaccination, expiration, manufacturer and serial number.

DOG PARK

Garbage service is provided by Waste Management (369-3080). Pick up is Wednesday as early as 6:00 a.m. Up-the-drive service is provided. Garbage service is paid in advance on the tax bill as a special charge. For information on large item pick-up, etc. contact Waste Management directly.

Submissions are due no later than 1:00 p.m. the Monday prior to the 3rd Wednesday of the month.

Plan Commission meetings are held as needed on the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m.

Submissions are due no later than 1:00 p.m. the Monday prior to the 1st Wednesday of the month.

PARKS

Dickten Park is located 1 block east of Lakeland Drive (Hwy C) on Rasmus Road just east of the Nashotah Fire Station. Facilities include a baseball diamond, soccer field, playground, basketball court, paved walking trail, volleyball, horseshoes and a shelter. The shelter is available for rent. Applications are available on the website. For shelter availability, contact the Clerk's Office (367-8440). The shelter availability is not guaranteed until the application and payment are received.

Nashotah Park is a county park located on Highway C just north of Highway 16. This park has hiking, cross country skiing trails, fishing, picnic areas and a fenced in dog park. For information call (896-8300).

POLICE

Nashotah has a part-time police department. Full time coverage is provided by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. For emergencies dial 911. For non-emergencies call 446-5070.

The Nashotah police provide house checks for those on vacation. Vacation house check forms can be obtained on the village website or from the Clerk's Office.

POST OFFICE

RECYCLING

A blue recycling can is provided to each homeowner. Replacement cans can be purchased from Advanced Disposal. Recycling material is collected with the garbage pick-up. Co-mingled bottles/cans/plastic should be rinsed out, lids removed, and papers should all be placed in the blue can and put out with the regular trash.

SEWER

Sewer service is provided to most areas in Nashotah. Persons living along Buckhorn Drive, Circle Drive, Elderwood Drive, Mertins Drive, Oakwood Avenue, and Woodsvew Drive do not have sewer service. They have septic systems.

Bills are generally mailed the first week of January, April, July and October each year. Billing is in advance for each quarter. Payment is due by 1:00 p.m. on the due date indicated on the bill. Contact the Clerk's Office for current rates.

Sewer Hook-Up fees for new homes are paid upon application for a building permit.

TAXES

Tax bills are mailed out between the 1st and 3rd weeks of December to the property owner or name listed on the assessment roll. Tax information can be obtained at www.waukeshacounty.gov – tax listing.

Taxes are paid at via the self-addressed envelope included with your tax bill. The 1st installment is due on or before January 31st. The balance is due on or before July 31st and is paid to the Waukesha County Treasurer.

NOTE: Personal Property Taxes are due by January 31st.

VOTING

New residents/voters must register to vote and must proof of residency (i.e. driver's license, utility bills. See *full list on website*) or other approved items showing name and current address. Voters must have resided in Nashotah a minimum of 28 days prior to the election to be eligible to vote in the election. Photo ID must be provided at the polls.

Elections are held at the Village Hall. The polls are open 7:00 a.m.- 8:00 p.m.

WATER

All properties in the Village of Nashotah are served by private wells.

YARD WASTE

Curbside yard waste pickup is available 9 times per year. See the schedule on the website. Materials allowed are: grass, leaves, garden debris bagged in brown paper biodegradable yard waste bags, disposable cardboard boxes no larger than 3 ft. x 3ft. x 3ft., or unlined 32 gallon garbage cans with handles weighing no more than 50 pounds per container. Brush cut in 4 foot lengths and securely bundled weighing no more than 50 pounds per bundle. Brush is branches less than 2 inches in diameter.
